

Tina Turner Concert Tour Scheduled for Two South Florida Venues

Tina Turner has announced that she will go on tour for the first time in eight years.

Turner, the 68-year-old Grammy-winning Rock and Roll Hall of Fame inductee, will begin a North American tour with a concert in Kansas City on Oct. 1.

"After performing with Beyoncé at the Grammy Awards, the response was overwhelming," Turner said in a statement. "Everywhere I went people were asking me when I was going back on tour. So after a lot of thought and planning, I can answer the only way I know how: See you in Kansas City, where we'll kick the tour off!"

The legendary singer will have two performances in South Florida - the most currently scheduled for one metropolitan area. On October 30, she will perform at the American Airlines Arena in Miami. Ms. Turner will hold her second show on November 2 at the BankAtlantic Center in Sunrise, FL.
